PLAYERS ARE NOT REQUIRED AT CHECK-IN.

**COACHES MUST BRING TWO (2) COPIES OF YOUR ROSTER AND COMPLETED TEAM BOOK TO CHECK-IN.
TEAM BOOK MUST BE PRESENT AT EACH GAME.**

Players can only play on one team the entire tournament, rosters will be doubled checked beginning of each game. If a player is caught playing on multiple teams, both teams will be forfeited & not eligible to play anymore games the duration of the tournament.

FAILURE TO CHECK-IN BEFORE SECOND GAME WILL RESULT IN A FORFEIT.

COACHING PASSES WILL BE ISSUED DURING BOOK CHECK ONLY

PASSES WILL BE ISSUED TO COACHES ON THE ROSTER ONLY

ADMISSION: Adults \$10 Daily Children \$5 Daily (Kids 10 & under) NO WEEKEND PASSES AVAILABLE

A STRICT WRISTBAND POLICY WILL BE ENFORCED.

Please check back frequently for updates and revised schedules.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY: Admission is waived for Players participating in the tournament and in uniform only. Players NOT in uniform will be charged for full admission. No exceptions will be granted!!

No balls are allowed in the gym except for warmups and must remain with the coach at all times. Anyone dribbling balls inside the gym will have ball confiscated. (COACHES PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN BASKETBALL FOR WARM UP) HOME TEAM PROVIDE GAME BALL.

Coaches please ensure your team is aware of this rules.

Oak Leaf Jr. High Campus Rules

- Coaches players are not allowed to walk throughout the property please keep a close eye on your players & make them aware of rules.
- If there are any damages done by your player the team will be dismissed from the tournament & coaches will be responsible for any damages.
- Picnic area to the right is available to all teams please make sure all trash is thrown in garbage can and not on the ground.
- The outside basketball courts to the left are available for any team to warmup and stretch before their game.
- Coaches please help us make this a successful tournament by working together, cleaning up after your team when leaving the court and picnic area. We can't do it alone thanks for participating.

AAU Boys Basketball Tournament Rules

Misbehavior/Ejections

1. Any coach ejected for fighting will be ineligible for the remainder of the tournament.
2. Players ejected for fighting are ineligible to participate in the team's next game. Additional penalties, up to exclusion from the tournament, may be imposed by Committee.
3. If a coach or player is ejected from a game for unsportsmanlike behavior (not fighting), he/she will be ineligible to participate in the next scheduled game.
4. If a coach or player is ejected a second time, he/she will be ineligible for the remainder of the tournament.
5. Coaches or Players who leave the bench to engage athletes or coaches on the playing floor during any period will be ineligible for the duration of the tournament.
6. The Committee may impose suspensions or other penalties for misbehavior which occurs at any time and at any location during the event.
7. Coaches and Athletes who engage in misbehavior are subject to additional disciplinary action from the AAU Boys' Basketball National Infractions Committee. Penalties may include suspension from AAU events in future years.

Press Rule

1. For 10U Age Divisions: Teams ahead by 20 points or more at any point in the second half must play defense behind their three-point arc. **First offense: Warning, Second and all additional offenses shot administrative technical.**
2. For 11U and older: Teams ahead by 20 points or more at any point in the second half must play defense behind their three-point arc. **First offense: Warning, Second and all additional offenses: 2 shot administrative technical.**

Equipment - Basketball Size

- A. 10U, 11U, & 12U grade division competitions shall use the 28.5 circumference girls basketball.
- B. 13U, 14U, 15U/9th, 16U/10th, 17U/11th grade/age division shall use the 29.5 circumference boys basketball.
